- Operating light vehicles, lawn mowers, tractors, small grass cutting/hedge trimming machinery, power tools, radio communications equipment and other specialized seasonal maintenance equipment assigned by the Operations Manager/Supervisor.
- Must be present with safety boots should be prepared to work outdoors and in attire that is
 appropriate for the weather conditions. Sunscreen and bug repellent are available at the Club and
 should be utilized for your protection when required. Utilization of other safety equipment may also
 be required.
- Able to operate all equipment safely and work in a safe manner as per Workplace Safety and Insurance Board (WSIB) & Occupational Health and Safety Act (OHSA)
- Advise the mechanic or your supervisor of any repairs or unsafe conditions of your equipment
- Assisting other team members
- Other assigned duties from time to time
