Summary

Our Ski and Snowboard Instructors are responsible for providing safe and enjoyable skiing experience to new & existing members of Caledon Ski Club. All of our Alpine Staff pride themselves as ambassadors on the ski hill to ensure members have a successful day and will return the next day.

What you will be doing:

Manage and facilitate daily ski/snowboard instructing, develop training plans, assist in training camp planning, and recruit performance staff. Ensure safety during training, manage equipment, supervise children, and create athlete/parent info packages. Complete progress reports and ensure client safety on slopes and chairlifts.

What's needed from you:

Outstanding verbal and written communication skills in English are essential. A minimum Level 1 certification from a recognized snow sport association is required, and candidates must be members in good standing. Strong interpersonal and motivational skills, along with the ability to work as a team player, are necessary. Instructors should be capable of skiing or snowboarding for up to 4.5 hours a day in winter conditions and lifting up to 50 pounds by carrying race gates and children on and off chairlifts or the ski hill.
